VISUAL ARTS

Campers will explore art concepts in a variety of media: including print-making, fiber arts, drawing, painting, mixed media and more.

2019 Art Instructors include: *Anna Jacobson*, artist and print-maker who has worked extensively with the Arts In Education Program with the ND Museum of Art, Jamestown Arts Center and the ND Council on the Arts Residency Program; *April Symes*, art instructor in the Warroad, MN Public Schools and *Diane Schill & Janet Jacobson* (ND Woolly Girls) Wales, ND fiber artists and entrepreneurs.

PERFORMING ARTS

Students enrolled in the performing arts classes will be studying creative dramatics, movement, improvisation and vocal music. Ensemble performance and teamwork will be a strong component of the classes.

The performing arts portion of the camp will provide students the opportunity to explore and create an original production with the guidance of the theater arts teaching staff. Stage movement, character development, improvisation, vocal performance and choreography are just some of the areas students will experience
